Cemetery Project Report February 2007

1. Work has continued inputting data received from correspondents. CD 4 was not published in early 2006, however the data for CD 5 is presently being prepared for publication in February 2007. This new CD will contain 250,837 names and 2165 cemeteries, an increase of 87,932 names and 366 cemeteries over CD 3 published in March 2005.

It is hoped that the new CD will have a feature to allow name searches in the NOTES field, which will pick up married as well as maiden names.

2. Much of the data in this CD was processed by Errol Dollenberg, it is to be expected that the next CD will have significantly fewer additions with this data source not now being available to us.

3. No progress was made with the idea of linking the library of cemetery (NOT HEADSTONES) photographs with the Cemetery Index. This will mean there will be a link between the Cemetery and its photograph, when available. Assistance will be required in deciding the proper additions to the cemetery Index, and in setting up naming conventions and photo format/size etc. At present our time is fully committed to inputting data received.

4. Contact was initiated and maintained with many correspondents and recorders through the year.
